WHITE PIGEON TOWNSHIP BOARD

The regular meeting of the White Pigeon Township Board was held on February 2, 2010, at 7:00 P.M. at the White Pigeon Township Hall located at 16975 US 12, White Pigeon, Michigan.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Don Gloy. Those in attendance were Supervisor Don Gloy, Trustees David Girton and Richard Strawser, Clerk Lois Phillips, and Treasurer Sherri Krogh. MINUTES AND FINANCIAL REPORT: The Board approved the minutes of the regular meeting held on January 5, 2010 along with the financial statement.

SEWER REPORT: The sewer board is updating the ordinance for the Industrial Pretreatment Plan.

AMBULANCE REPORT: None.

FIRE ADVISORY REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS: The Board reviewed the Fire Chief's report.

DERON ANDERSON-SCOUTMASTER TROOP #419: Supervisor Gloy welcomed the scouts who were guests at the meeting. He praised and encouraged them to continue their involvement in the community.

CEMETERY TRACTOR/MOWER REPLACEMENT: Phillips made a motion seconded by Krogh to direct the sexton of the White Pigeon Cemetery to obtain another bid for the purchase of a new tractor for the cemetery. All in favor were Phillips, Krogh, and Girton. Voting nay were Gloy and Strawser. Motion carried.

PETITION ACCEPTANCE REQUIREMENTS: The Board discussed the standards for accepting petitions.

OTHER BUSINESS: A follow up meeting for the Vision Committee for the White Pigeon Community will be held on Thursday, March 25th, 2010 at 6:30 P.M. at the township hall.
