WHITE PIGEON TOWNSHIP BOARD

The regular meeting of the White Pigeon Township Board was held on May 5, 2010, at 7:00 P.M. at the White Pigeon Township Hall located at 16975 US 12, White Pigeon, Michigan.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Don Gloy. Those in attendance were Supervisor Don Gloy, Trustees David Girton & Richard Strawser, Clerk Lois Phillips, and Treasurer Sherri Krogh. Guests in attendance were Troy Andrews, Jean Tefft, Trudy Hornell, VI Schuler, and Tyler Royce.

MINUTES AND FINANCIAL REPORT: The Board approved the minutes of the regular meeting held on April 6, 2010 along with the financial statement.

Girton made a motion seconded by Strawser to pay all the bills as presented by the clerk and to approve the bills already paid by the clerk. Those in favor were Gloy, Strawser, Phillips, Krogh, and Girton. No nays. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT: The progress of the Hill St. road project was discussed.

ZONING OFFICER'S REPORT: The Board reviewed the report.

LAND DIVISION/ASSESSOR'S REPORT: None.

PLANNING COMMISSION REPORT: The next meeting will be Monday, May 10, 2010 at noon.

AMBULANCE REPORT: None.

FIRE ADVISORY REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS: The Board reviewed the Fire Chief's report. Gloy made a motion seconded by Krogh to accept Scott McDonald as a firefighter pending the necessary physicals and drug screening. Those in favor were Phillips, Gloy, Krogh, Girton, and Strawser. There were no nays. Motion carried.

APPOINTMENT TO AMBULANCE AUTHORITY: Krogh made a motion seconded by Girton to appoint Phillips as the White Pigeon Township's representative to the Ambulance Authority. Krogh will serve as the alternate representative. Those in favor were Phillips, Gloy, Krogh, Girton, and Strawser. There were no nays. Motion carried.

APPOINTMENT TO PARKS AND RECREATIONS: None.

HILL STREET: The Board will review the letters in favor of the project at its May 18, 2010 Budget work session.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Krogh made a motion seconded by Gloy to contract with the White Pigeon Community Association at a cost of \$750.00. Those in favor were Phillips, Gloy, Krogh, Girton, and Strawser. There were no nays. Motion carried.

The Board discussed the installation of foundations at the White Pigeon Cemetery. Further study will be made before a decision is made.

Gloy informed the Board of a donation from Ruth Harris to the White Pigeon Township Fire Department. The Board discussed how the money should be used. Further discussion and thought will occur before a decision is made.

Phillips will call the insurance representative to determine the coverage for part-time workers at the cemetery.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned by consensus at 9:05 P.M.
